# ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING October 17, 2013 2012/2013 ANNUAL REPORT

**Our Mission Statement:** To improve the quality of life for people affected by spina bifida and hydrocephalus through advocacy, research, education, and support.

#### **ADMINISTRATION**

#### Office:

- Kelty Coburn continued to work 30 hours/week as our Program Manager until July 12, 2013. Darlene Cathcart continued as Administrative Assistant for 15 hours/week until she was hired as the new Program Manager as of July 8, 2013. There was one week of overlap. Darlene works 20 hours/week.
- Alexis Millar was hired on July 12, 2013 as the Fund Development and Communications Coordinator. Alexis works 20 hours/week.
- Kiray Jones-Mollerup worked 420 hours over the summer as our Fund Development Coordinator through the Canada Summer Jobs Program through the Federal Government

# Membership:

- We now have 251 members on our Membership List
- 117 members renewed their membership during the last fiscal year

#### Strategic Plan:

- The Board continues to follow the Strategic Plan that was developed in March 2012
- An Adult Focus Group was held on January 26, 2013. Three goals were identified.
  - 1. Continue to increase awareness with a specific focus on education to the general public on issues that our adult population faces
  - 2. Connect our adult population through events and programs
  - 3. Advocate for the complex medical needs of the adult members

 Mackenzie Doll and Keighley Schofield are the recipients for the Dr. Peter Bowen Scholarship, with each receiving \$1,000 towards post-secondary education
